RULES FOR RUSSIAN PIANO FESTIVAL/COMPETITION

The competition will be held at the Sherman Clay Piano Store at 1624 4th St. in downtown Seattle.

The competition will last all day. Leave adequate time to arrive well before your assigned playing time. No changes or special scheduling accommodations will be possible. You may observe other contestants as you wish.

Teachers and/or students are responsible for presenting the judge with an original music score (no photocopies) with measures marked.

Dress Code: No tennis shoes, baggy pants, or jeans. Boys – white shirts and dark pants. Girls – dresses, skirts, or nice trousers.

All music will be performed by memory.

No warm-up instruments will be available on the day of the competition.

Contestants must compete in their own group (suggested by teacher) based on chosen pieces. Contestants from Group E (Concerto) may also participate in one of the solo groups.

Please time your selection(s) carefully – this will determine how much time you are assigned on the schedule. No changes will be possible in the program once the application is received.

Applications will be considered incomplete and will not be accepted unless all items in the Application Form are filled out and the check is enclosed. Teachers will be notified by e-mail of their student's playing time.

Please submit applications as early as possible after September 1. Applications will only be accepted between September 1 and November 5.

TEACHERS – A maximum of seven (7) students per teacher will be allowed to compete.
